## FROM THE MINISTER

From the time we get up in the morning, we are busy. Many people rush off to work or begin their tasks around the house without even eating breakfast. It is easy to let the day pass by without a moment of *peace* and *quiet*.

In Psalm 46:10 the command to *be quiet* is coupled with the result of *knowing that He is God*. Could it be that in order to truly recognize God's presence in our lives, we must make time to silence ourselves before Him?

Sitting quietly is a discipline that requires practice. Just as in our relationships with each other, learning to be a good listener as we pray to God is important. If prayer remains one-sided (all talk, no listening), we miss out on what He wants to say to us.

Although God may not speak to us in an audible voice, He will direct our thinking and speak to our hearts. Stillness allows us to dwell on God's sovereignty (authority), His goodness, and His love for us. He wants us to remember that He is God and that He is in control, regardless of our circumstances or what is going on in our world. Be quiet... and know that I am God.
