### WORSHIP AND WEB STREAM INFORMATION

Worship services continue to be web streamed *live* on Sunday mornings starting at 9 a.m.

Go to <u>prestoncitycongregational.org</u>. You can also watch the service later in the day via the archive system also on the site. Did you know that 120 viewers tuned in from 26 states, 81 cities, and 2 countries last Sunday? Were you one of them? You can also worship in person (60 people per service). You are asked to follow the safety guidelines which are listed on the church website above. Those who wish to attend a service (9 or 10:30) MUST contact the church office (860.887.4647) no later than THURSDAY (11 a.m.) <u>each week</u> and give their name, as well as the number of people who will be attending, and which service they plan to attend. Masks are required, and temperatures will be checked upon entering the building. We hope to see you this Sunday.

### **CHRISTMAS EVE SERVICES**
