# FROM THE MINISTER Special Gift Update

God never ceases to amaze me!

You may recall that back on October 5<sup>th</sup>, it was mentioned in the *Little Pilgrim*, that the church was facing a "short-fall" of approximately \$22,000 due to the cancellation of fundraising events, because of Covid-19. A few weeks later, the short-fall increased to \$28,000. A "Special Gift" appeal was made to the members and friends of our church, asking them to consider giving a monetary gift to help reduce (or eliminate) the short-fall. Over the weeks that followed, envelopes marked "Special Gift" appeared in the offering plate and arrived in the mail. Thanks to your giving, and the remaining unspent monies (line items) in the 2020 budget, it is possible that we will not only meet our budget, but begin 2021 with a small surplus.

That's great news! We won't know the exact numbers for a couple more days, but it looks promising! We appreciate the many people who gave to the appeal, as well as friends in the community, and those viewing the web stream services.

You are a remarkable congregation; one that rises to the occasion, and meets a challenge. You are faithful and loyal to the church, and to God. He continues to bless us for our faithfulness to Him.
