WORSHIP AND WEB STREAM INFORMATION

Worship services continue to be web streamed *live* on Sunday mornings starting at 9 a.m.

Those who wish to attend a service (9 or 10:30) MUST contact the church office (860.887.4647) no later than THURSDAY (11 a.m.), and give their name, as well as the number of people who will be attending, and which service they plan to attend. Masks are required, and temperatures will be checked upon entering the building.



ANNUAL MEETING POSTPONED

At the January 20th meeting of the Standing Committee, members thought it would be best to move the date of the Annual Meeting (February 14th) to Sunday, April 18th. It is hoped that by then, Covid-19 conditions will have improved in our state.
