### WORSHIP AND WEB STREAM INFORMATION

Worship services continue to be web streamed *live* on Sunday mornings starting at 9 a.m. Go to

prestoncitycongregational.org. You can also watch the service later in the day via the archive system also on the site. Did you know that 76 viewers from 2 countries, 22 states, and 51 cities tuned in last Sunday? Archive viewership last week was 23. Were you one of them? We hope to see you in person one Sunday soon!



Dear Members and Friends, We remind you that starting June 6<sup>th</sup> (This Sunday):

- The wearing of masks will be <u>optional</u> during worship services. If you have **not** been vaccinated, we encourage you (for your safety) to continue wearing a mask. Parents will decide if their child(ren) will wear masks while in the Sanctuary or during Sunday School.
- You no longer need to call the church office to let us know you will be at worship, and temperatures will not be taken upon entering the building.
- In addition to the double doors, you may also enter and exit through the front doors.
- All pew cushions, hymnals, and Bibles will be returned to the Sanctuary.
- Worship folders and the order of worship we once knew will return. You can pick them up by the upperlevel elevator and front door entrance. Offering plates will be available at both locations; communion packets will be there as well on the first Sunday of the month.
- I will be greeting worshipers (shaking hands) on the front lawn with those who feel comfortable doing so.

As was the case when the pandemic began, we may need to make some adjustments moving forward, please be patient.

With the arrival of your new minister (Rev. Rae) at the end of July, we believe it is important for him to observe worship as we have been accustomed to these many years.

The "live" web streaming of the 9 a.m. service will continue to be offered for those unable to attend in person.

This is an exciting time in our church. We have a wonderful story to continue telling, and there are many more people in the communities where we live that need to hear it!

If you've been away from the church, it's time to *come home*. You've been missed!
