Pastor's Corner

Over the years, I have enjoyed reading the works of many great poets. I've referenced their writings from time-to-time in many sermons – even funerals. I especially appreciate the writings of the New England poet Robert Frost. In my home hangs a beautiful cross-stich of an old grass-covered road in the woods which leads to a fork in the road inviting the traveler to choose the road he will continue on. The words beneath this image read:

"Two roads diverged in a wood, and I --- I took the one less traveled by, and that has made all the difference." (The Road Not Taken, R. Frost)

This poem and these words in particular, sum up my life, my ministry, my time in Preston.

When starting out in ministry, there were some people who thought there were other roads I should consider traveling; better roads, more profitable roads, roads that would lead to greater accomplishments, more than a small country church could offer me. I was told, "Don't expect much! They're set in their ways. You won't stay there long" (Boy, were they wrong!). I had the opportunity to remain in the church I served for seven years following my Ordination. It was an established, high energy congregation, a leader in the community. But I felt a nudge to travel another road, a new road, an unknown road. I thought about Abraham in the Old Testament. He didn't know where he was going when God spoke to him about traveling to a new land. But with faith and trust in God, Abraham walked a road "less traveled," and so did I.

I have no regrets about the road I traveled in life – the road that led me here to Preston 36 years ago. I took *the road less traveled, and that has made all the difference* in my life. Thank you for walking the road with me, and thank you, God, for nudging me many times along the way.

He has great things instore for each of us when we invite Him to travel with us through life.
