Ken Medema is a fairly well-known, award-winning singer/songwriter who happens to be blind. He has written hundreds of songs through the years (some I enjoy more than others). More than the melody, I am impressed with the lyrics he writes. A few years back, he wrote the song, If This Is Not a Place. In it, he asks several important questions about the church. Here are some of the words:

If this is not a place where tears are understood,

Where can I go to cry?

If this is not a place where questions can be asked,

Where can I go to seek?

If this is not a place where you accept me just as I am

Where can I go to be free?

If this is not a place where I can try, and grow, and love,

Where do I go just to be me?

Over the years, I have learned many important life-lessons from you, like what it means to be a church – the body of Christ. The church is more than just a place to worship. It's a "Sanctuary," a sacred place, unlike any other place. It's a refuge, a place to go to; sometimes by yourself – to reflect, pray, cry, ask questions, figure out life, and how to develop a living faith that will endure whatever comes your way.
