Pastor's Corner

Some years ago, I came to New England in the Fall for studies, but it wasn't until the Spring that I truly fell in love with it. Mostly, I was enamored with how nature came to life with the growing of brilliant colors and with the fragrance of cherry blossoms and Magnolia trees that fill the air. Although I admire nature's beauty, I have never personally had a green thumb and have always marveled at those who do.

When I did try a hand at my version of horticulture (a single potted plant), the times I remember most were when, after looking at a brown patch of dirt for weeks, after remembering to water, but not overwater, trying to guess the right amount of sun or shade... finally, the moment when my effort was rewarded with a tiny green sprout emerging from the dirt.

Our lives develop in much the same way. The growth that we see is the result of much work and preparation that is often not visible as it takes place just beneath the surface. We often wrestle and struggle to emerge in specific areas of our lives, endeavoring to break the surface as our best selves.

The Church at its best, is a place where lives are nourished in this way. A place where they continue to blossom and evolve, and each of us has a role to play in this process. Listen to how the apostle Paul describes the collective effort that aids the growth of an individual in any community of faith; "one plants, the other waters, but God gives the increase." (1 Corinthians 3:6; paraphrased) Whenever we sow seeds of truth, with kindness and love, we are planting seeds that may eventually take root. When we encourage the members of our church family, we continue to water.

It is a process, but with continued effort, the day soon approaches when, with the Grace of God's light, tiny, healthy green leaves begin to sprout. My prayer this week is that we actively seek ways to be the catalyst of growth in someone's world and, because of your faithfulness, that God continues to bring growth to your own life, just as His faithfulness causes the life of our church family to spring forth and grow.
