Pastor's Corner

The Grace of God

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God" (Ephesians 2:8).

What is the Easter story all about? It is a depiction of the Grace of God. I am fond of the Easter season, perhaps partly because I am fond of a good love story... And Easter, in some measure, is the end of a chapter in the greatest love story ever told: that God, once separated from the object of His affection (you and I), decided that this was a relationship worth keeping, and He devised a plan to do so. Listen to the Psalmist describe it.

"Listen! My beloved! Look! Here he comes, leaping across the mountains, bounding over the hills. My beloved is like a gazelle or a young stag. Look! There he stands behind our wall, gazing through the windows, peering through the lattice. My beloved spoke and said to me, "Arise, my darling, my beautiful one, come with me." (Song of Solomon 2:8-10)

This is an image of Christ leaping across the mountainous barriers of sin, peering through the lattice of time, down through 42 generations, showing himself only in a measure, waiting until the perfect time to reveal his plan... And then, in the fullness of time, a God who sits high decides to stoop low in order to redeem broken souls. Now that's Grace! That's also the Easter message we continue to celebrate this week!
