FROM THE MINISTER...

Be still my soul

1 Peter 5:7 invites us to cast our cares upon the Lord, a task that is easier said than done considering all of the cares of the modern world. Perhaps it is a task that can only be accomplished when we focus on the one whose voice still has control of the storms and waves of life. Particularly when we feel disappointed by decisions made, or when things seem out of our control, this is the time to lean not to our own understanding, but rather, to turn to the promises from the divine, who still has power over the storms, even the ones that may occasionally rage on in our hearts. This week I invite you to practice just that, as you consider a meditation on surrender from St. Augustine.

"Has someone insulted you? It is the wind beating against you. Have you become angry? It is the swell mounting.

Does temptation arise? It is the wind blowing.

Is your soul troubled? It is the waves rising up.

Wake up Christ and let him speak to you.

'Who, then, is this that even the wind and the sea obey him?' Who is he? 'His is the sea, for he has made it'; 'all things were made by him' (Ps 95:5; Jn 1:3). So imitate the winds and the sea: obey your Creator. The sea shows itself to be docile to Christ's voice and do you remain deaf? The sea obeys, the winds drop, and do you continue to blow? What are we trying to say by this? Speaking, getting upset, plotting revenge: isn't this continuing to blow and not wanting to give way before Christ's word? When your heart is stirred up, don't allow yourself to be swamped by the waves."
